We wanted to share some quick facts and some ideas on things to bring on your trip.

Quick Facts:

- YWAM Sand Diego/Baja is a growing organization with more than 220 full time staff that live and work in San Diego and the Baja region of Mexico with locations at San Antonio Del Mar and Ensenada.
- Homes of Hope has placed over 8,000 families in homes globally. Two of our other main building locations are the Dominican Republic and Costa Rica.
- Each house takes 2 full days to build or a total of about 16 hours.
- We'll have the concrete slab poured and the material and tools already at the build site when you arrive.
- We'll have experienced builders working with your team to ensure you stay on schedule.
- Everything is provided, including food and water for your team, and it's safe and fun. We have prepared a list of what you might want to bring for your Homes of Hope event. We suggest your packing be restricted to one medium-sized suitcase and one carry-on bag only.

Please note that these are only suggestions for your group.

What to Bring List:

- Personal toiletries (Shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
- Camera
- Moist towelettes or wipes
- Sunblock, a hat and sunglasses
- Work gloves
- A towel and washcloth
- We provide bedding for you so you can leave your sleeping bag at home

Suggested Clothing:

- Work pants (or shorts of modest length)
- Work shirts
- Work shoes (closed-toed shoes required)
- Casual clothing for dinners
- Light jacket or sweater
